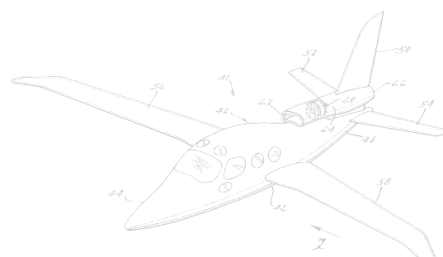

Novelty Search - Business Method, Electrical, or Software: Focuses on the most unique details of an invention or its most patentable qualities.	\$575
Novelty Search - Biotech, Chemical, Genetic, or Medical: Focuses on the most unique details of an invention or its most patentable qualities.	\$675*
Patent Collection Search: Shows the evolution of a technology over a specified period of time. Both expired and un-expired patents are included as references.	\$950

Search Prices Explained

- All searches are for inventions of average complexity. Patent searches for inventions of greater than average complexity are given a project price quote before a search is begun.
- *Price does not include commercial database time for more complex Chemical, Genetic, and Biotech searches. A price quote for complex Chemical, Genetic, and Biotech searches is given before a search is begun.
- Search prices may be different for projects that include searching of multiple foreign patent authorities (Japan, Germany, S. Korea, etc.). A price quote for multiple extra foreign authority searches is given before a search is begun.
- All prices are in US dollars.
