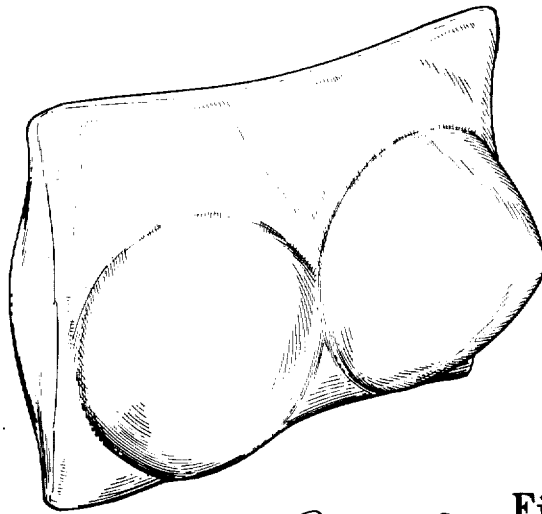

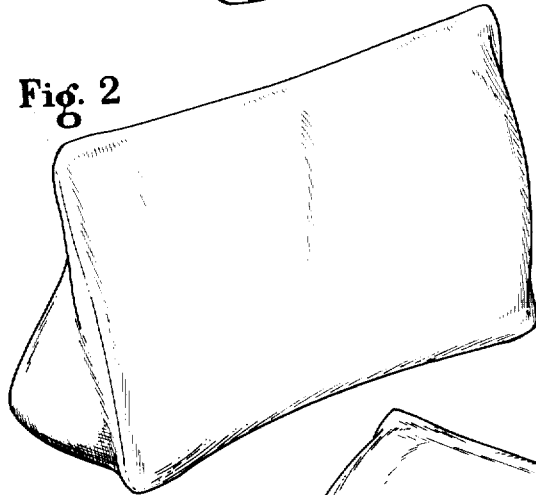

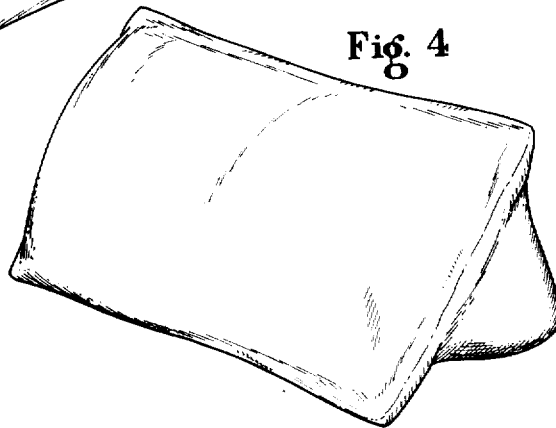

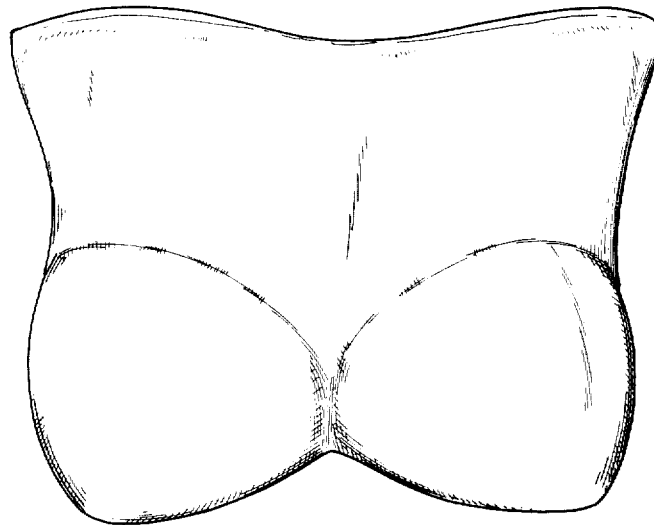


FIG. 1 is a front and left side perspective view of a pillow showing my new design;
